

## **Credential Rules for** **33rd 2016 Legislative District Caucus**

Note: The following rules were formatted for the LD Caucus at the Credentials Committee meeting on April 10, 2016.

1. Attendees to the Legislative District Caucus who have no paperwork to validate their election from precincts that have not paperwork (minutes, notes, credentials forms, etc) validating their election will be placed with the Alternates. If a validated Delegate/Alternate or member of their precinct arrives to validate them before the final Credentials Report, they will be seated as normal. If not, they will lose their claimed status.
2. Attendees to the Legislative District Caucus who have paperwork to validate their election, or their precincts have paperwork (minutes, notes, credentials forms, etc) validating their election, but their Presidential Preference status at the time of the Precinct Caucus showed a different status from the Delegate or Alternate Presidential Preference they were elected for, will be sent to the Credentials Committee room, at which time a decision by the Credentials Committee will be made based on information regarding the Precinct Caucus election and any other Precinct Caucus members who arrive and are willing to affirm regarding the election.
3. No changes will be made to the status of Delegates/Alternates due to challenges regarding incorrect tallies.
